<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility to conduct a monitoring visit. The children were just finishing up snack and dancing and singing to child appropriate music. They had a variety of musical instruments, books, blocks cars, dinosaurs and small toys. The operator played blocks with the children and engaged in their play with them. The entryway contained the children's belongings and a parent board with all the necessary postings posted.</p> <p>Everyone cleaned up together and the operator applied sunscreen, gave them their water bottles and made sure that they had their hats on. They went outside to their fenced in play area. The operator set up water play for them and everyone was very engaged in this activity. The outdoor play had had lots of shade, a variety of climbers, slides, ride on toys, balls, and containers for pouring. There were multiple play surfaces, mud, sand and grass and the operator has a load of mulch and sand coming next week for the sandbox and to add surfacing under the climbers.</p> <p>The children came inside for lunch and washed their hands. All their food is from home, and everyone ate at a table except one child in a highchair. Mealtime was pleasant and the operator fed some of the children and played and sang with them. After lunch diapers were changed and everyone prepared for nap.</p> <p>The operator obviously enjoyed the children's company and was kind and gentle with them at all times. She comforted them and knew their likes and dislikes very well.</p>
