Throughout the visit, the Operator was observed singing songs with the children such as "Hop Little Bunny" and "Penguin Waddle". The children were seen smiling and laughing as they played peek-a-boo with one another and the Operator. Only positive child guidance was observed. The Operator encourages language with the children through modelling. "It's stuck, isn't it? Let's see if we can fix it! Look, we did it!". The children had used pudding for a finger-painting activity. Quotes and their artwork were displayed for all to see. The Operator sang a clean-up song and encouraged the children to help put the toys away before washing hands for afternoon snack.

Attendance records and daily information sheets are being completed. Medication is being stored properly, and Administration of Medication forms are being used. The children's belongings are stored separately and are labelled. The environment is clean and inviting. A new wooden play kitchen has been added, A learning story and pictures of the children playing with the new kitchen were posted on the wall above the kitchen. There are current learning stories, pictures and artwork posted throughout.
