## **General Comments**

Comments:

A monitoring Inspection occurred July 2025

32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area

materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.

Deficiency is now compliant

The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities across indoor and outdoor environments. The children were observed building with wood planks, playing in the sandbox, blowing bubbles, and looking for snails outdoors. Indoors, the children were observed playing with trucks, playing with Barbies, drawing, playing in the dramatic play area, and playing with farm animals. The educators indicated the children are currently interested in music, dinosaurs, trucks, baby dolls/Barbies, sand/water play, and camping. The educators shared that they have a class bear, "Lulu," that the children take turns taking home on the weekends that has a journal to document Lulu's travels.

The room was set up with materials that invite the children to play, including a s'mores campfire tuff tray and a bug matching game. Several forms of documentation were visible in the indoor environment. These included learning stories, learning webs, photographs, and the children's artwork.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility's license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

A conversation took place with the administrator on the following:

• Removing all wood that is splintering or decaying from the play yard.
