General Comments

Upon arrival of licensing staff, the first school bus had arrived. There was only a small group of children in attendance today and ratio was more than met. The children were sitting at the table making bracelets with beads and listening to music. One child started playing with legos and another started drawing. The educators were engaged and playing with the children. When the second bus arrived, one educator met the children outside and the other got the attendance sheet ready. One child joined the lego play and the other went to the couch. An educator went over to the child on the couch and asked if they were feeling ok. The child's temperature was taken, and they had no fever.

The educators gave a 5-minute warning before going outside so the children could prepare. They cleaned up and got ready to go outside. The educators brought the first aid kit, sunscreen, and water bottles out. Some children played in the sandbox and others played tic tac toe. The educators were sitting and playing with the children. They were all playing in the sandbox together and then some children decided to do a tire obstacle course. The educators played with the children and greeted parents as they arrived.

The indoor environment was clean and well organized. Various resources and materials are accessible to the children, such as costumes, legos, art supplies, dolls, trucks, trains, boardgames, puzzles, a kitchen, books, basketball nets, as well as air hockey and foosball tables. The children's artwork and Halloween decorations were posted on the walls. The outdoor play space had various materials available, such as cones, tires, balls, tic tac toe, connect-4, and a sandbox with buckets and shovels.

Five child files were checked and found to be complete. A conversation was had with the educators about standing water in the tires. The educator explained that they've poked holes in the tires but will drill bigger holes to prevent water accumulation. Please ensure that standing water from tires is routinely drained to prevent bacteria.
