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<p>General Comments</p> <p>As it was a beautiful day, drop off for the preschool children occurred in the outdoor play space. The outdoor play space is an extension of the indoor play space. The learning centres were labelled, with a variety of materials. The learning centres included a large dramatic play area, a sand area, a construction area that included blocks, lego, and hard hats, a music wall, a chalk board wall, a water centre, a literacy corner, a gross motor area with a climbing structure and slides, a paint wall and a loose parts area.</p> <p>Inside many of the classrooms, you could find photos of the children, family walls, and learning stories. The administrator stated that the educators usually complete one learning story a week. The children's art work was also visible. Licensing staff had a conversation with the administrator regarding obtaining curriculum support for the educators to encourage more child led activities. A referral will be made to the curriculum team.</p> <p>The facility has a food program that most parents opt to have for two snacks and lunch. The menu was being followed at the time of visit.</p> <p>All children's files were complete. Medication records, incident reports, and immunization records were evident in the files. Some of the children have severe allergies or conditions. The allergy management plans were present. All other documentation required for licensing was organized and complete.</p> <p>As discussed the list of approved service providers are outlined on the Worksafe NB website. Also, relief staff are not included in the 50 percent educational requirement.</p> <p>I can now recommend facility for licensing.</p>
