Once each child has a designated space to store their belongings a picture will be sent to licensing staff -Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector -Operator shares that going outside has been hard lately because children do not have the proper clothing's, parent have been advised to bring warmer clothes. -Lunch and snacks are provided at recognized meal periods

-Daily rest period is adapted to meet individual needs

Observations: When arriving at the center children were getting ready to eat their lunch, the infant settle in for is nap and the preschool children transitioned into a free play period.
