Comments: Administrator provides the missing valid first aid and certificate to the inspector during the follow up inspection. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: Inspector is onsite to complete the follow up inspection and verifies the child's file that was missing medical practitioner information. Inspector observes that this section had now been completed with the required information. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: Administrator is able to provide the inspector that the monthly review and maintenance plan has been completed for the month of February including the previous verifications for this renewal period. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Inspector verifies both diaper changing areas and observes that the diaper changing procedures have been posted. Deficiency is now compliant.			

### General Comments

The inspector is onsite to complete the follow-up inspection and observes the preschool-aged children engaged in outdoor play in the morning, watching a educational show on a iPad, followed by lunch and their rest period.

Afterschool children are present at the center for the full day due to March Break. The inspectors observe them participating in various activities, including playing in a long-colored tunnel, painting their nails, and engaging in free play within the common area. In the afternoon, the children quietly watch a movie.

Inspector has discussion with administrator that the professional Learning Hours need to be completed before March 31st as part of the renewal.
