General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, both Educators had left the facility to meet the children at the school for afternoon dismissal. First aid kits were taken with Educators. Upon arriving back at the facility, personal belongings were put away, hands were washed and attendance records were updated.

The Educator explained that this afternoon they would have free play, afternoon snack and then have the opportunity to make an ornament for the Christmas Tree. One group of children asked for coloring pages and paint markers. Another small group of children were observed engaging in a Pokeman battle. Both Educators were actively engaged in the activities. A gentle reminder was heard before it was time to clean up and prepare for snack time. The tables were cleaned and the children lined up to go wash their hands. The Educator sat at the table and read today's section from the Advent Calendar book. The Educator engaged the children throughout the story, asking questions and extending the story.

Once the children had finished snack time, they sat together to talk about what ornament they would be making. The room was decorated for the upcoming Holiday season. The children had made several snowflakes that were hanging from the ceiling and walls. Several positive changes were noted in the indoor environment since the previous Monitoring Inspection. New furniture and play materials were observed throughout the classroom. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were engaged in conversations and activities throughout the afternoon. The Educators spoke with kindness and in a calm tone when supporting a child through transition periods.
