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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, one child was present on site with an Educator while another Educator was meeting another child at a nearby school for afternoon dismissal. Invitations such as Play-Doh and accessories, crafting and coloring materials as well as a variety of blocks were set out on the tables. The children had the opportunity to engage in free play upon arrival at the facility. The children decided to sit together at the tables, drawing and coloring. Later, the older child taught their peer and Educators how to make a paper airplane. Once they had finished making their airplanes they were observed throwing them around the classroom.</p> <p>Today was International Waffle Day. One of the Educators had brought in pre-packaged waffles for the children to have for afternoon snack. The children were able to add maple syrup, whipped cream and sprinkles on top of their waffles. Hands were washed and the group said a prayer together before eating snack. The Educators sat with the children as they ate, engaging in conversation. As the children finished eating, they stacked their plates and engaged in free play. Later in the afternoon the children prepared to do a flower craft before going outside for end of day.</p> <p>Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were actively engaged with the children throughout the afternoon and offered their assistance when needed. The classroom was bright and welcoming. Several Easter decorations were observed throughout the classroom and on a tree. The Educators explained they are preparing for an Easter Egg Hunt this weekend.</p>
