<p>General Comments</p> <p>Upon the arrival of licensing staff, the children had not yet arrived from school. During this time, staff and child files were reviewed and found to be in compliance.</p> <p>At approximately 2:50 p.m., educators met the children attending the after-school program in the hallway. Before entering the classroom, the educator asked the children to wash their hands and then proceed to the table so attendance could be taken.</p> <p>As it was the second-to-last day of school, the classroom had been prepared for a glow party. Blue lights and decorations were set up to celebrate the end of the school year. Glow sticks and bracelets were placed on the table, and the educator told the children they could take one of each.</p> <p>During snack time, the educator read a book about the last day of school. Afterwards, the children returned their lunch boxes to their cubbies with the supervision of an educator. The children then returned to the classroom and engaged in free play and threw the balloons around and danced. The educator facilitated a "don't let the balloons touch the ground game" while another educator was observed finding things that would glow under the blue light with the groups. Some children played with barbies in the corner. Tables were washed once everyone finished their snack.</p> <p>Throughout the visit, only positive child guidance was observed. The program is equipped with a variety of age-appropriate materials. Fire drills are being conducted monthly.</p> <p>Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.</p>
