<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at 2:30pm for a monitoring inspection. Upon arrival, the educators were observed preparing a Mother's Day activity for the children. At 2:55pm, an educator welcomed the children in the hallway. The children were brought to the end of the hallway to store their personal belongings. Please ensure that all hooks have the children's names to identify the children's spaces. After, the children entered the classroom and sat down at the tables. Daily attendance was taken in the form of "roll call". An educator was heard going over the daily schedule and activities.</p> <p>After, the educators were observed taking out ribbons, buttons, pipe cleaners and other accessories so that the children could make Mother's Day cards. An educator was heard encouraging the children to make a card for their mother, grandmother, sister or a special person. The children were observed engaging in the card making activity. The educators were observed offering help to the children and praising their work. Once the children were done, they engaged in free play activities. Some children played with dolls, toy trucks, while others engaged in imaginary play. A verbal prompt was given to the children before transitioning to afternoon snack time. The educators and children were observed cleaning up as a group.</p> <p>An educator was observed bringing the children to the end of the hallway to gather their lunch boxes. A friendly reminder to ask the children to wash their hands before having their snacks. During snack time, an educator was observed reading a story book aloud to the group. The children were supervised while they ate. After eating, the children returned to free play activities.</p> <p>The indoor environment was clean and well organized. Various and sufficient indoor play materials were present in the classroom. The necessary information was posted on a bull tin board at the entrance of classroom. The educators were actively engaged in the children's interests and were in touch with the children's needs.</p>
