Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observes that one staff member, who is now of legal age to complete the required verification, has only a criminal record check on file and does not have a vulnerable sector check. Each staff member must have a criminal record check/vulnerable sector check. The staff member is immediately replaced by another staff member. Later during the visit, the staff member provides a copy of the completed vulnerable sector check. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor is on-site to conduct the renewal inspection and is present during outdoor play, indoor play, lunchtime, and naptime. During the morning, the school-age children participate in a STEAM program. Children are observed engaging in a variety of activities, including bracelet making, building with LEGO, imaginative play with Pet Shop toys, and creating personalized name crafts using a variety of materials of their choice. During naptime, children who no longer nap participate in quiet activities. A discussion takes place regarding the board of directors. The administrator indicates that the organization is currently updating its board members. The board of directors must consist of at least five elected members, of whom at least 20% are parents or guardians of a child receiving services at the centre. Once the update is completed, a copy of the board information must be submitted to the licensing department. A discussion also takes place regarding board member files. Each board member must have a file maintained on-site that contains all required verification. During the visit, the ratio is respected.
