<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including painting, Lego, fine motor activities and drawing. Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environment that support the children's current interests (painting, art, Lego and UNO). When the children arrived from school, they are offered a choice of snack in the cafeteria or free play in the indoor play area. One educator sat with the children in the cafeteria and engaged in meaningful conversations while they ate their snack. The rest of the children went to the indoor play area and engaged in a variety of building experiences with their educator.</p> <p>QA Monitor left recommendations of types of documentation that supports the school-age children's learning that could be displayed. Examples of documentation that could be added, but not limited to surveys, tournament brackets, surveys, quotes, lists of questions, recipes and single photos with a small description. It was recommended adding a binder to the environment with a collection of documentation of children's learning. This allows children and the licensing team to revisit children's interests and learning throughout the year.</p> <p>Handwashing routines were observed before snack. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.</p>
