Upon arrival of licensing staff, the children were playing with magnet tiles. The operator was sitting and playing with the children as they built towers and rockets out of magnets. They cleaned up the magnets and the operator set up the sand table. The children played with Kinetic sand. The children then got some monster trucks to bring outside. The operator helped the children get dressed and they went outside together. The children played with their trucks and slid them down the slide. The children and operator then went for a walk down the trail. Once the children said they were starting to get cold, they returned inside. The children and operator went to the washroom to wash their hands.

The children sat down at the table to have snack. The children then did board puzzles. The operator was heard praising the children as they completed them. The children and operator then sat together to do a matching puzzle, where there were various images, words, and numbers. The children were seen naming the images, talking about them, and counting. The children then wanted to play with Play-Doh. The children played and were seen making capes and jetpacks for their action figures. The infant explored the playroom and played with musical instruments and blocks. The operator took out googly eyes, pipe cleaners, and pom-poms, and the children made Play-Doh monsters. The children then played with flowers and made jungles. The children asked to watch Paw Patrol video before lunchtime.

The operator is attentive and engaged in the children's play. The operator redirects the children when needed. Only positive child guidance was observed. Daily Information sheets were completed for the infant. Please ensure the child files are completed with the required information.
