Comments: The white shelves in the classrooms are wobbly. The screws need to be tightened, or the shelves need to be replaced. The glass on of the exterior doors is cracked. This needs to be repaired. There is a screw sticking out on the diaper change table. This needs to be repaired.

Comments: The infant's play area has only one surface. A second surface needs to be added.

Comments: There is insufficient shade in the preschool outdoor space. More shade needs to be added.

Comments: The classrooms are sharing one container of art materials. Each classroom needs to have their own materials that the children have access to.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>The children were in the outdoor play space when I arrived. The children were observed playing on the slide/climbing structure, looking for bugs, walking on the wooden stepping blocks, running around the play space. The infant playground does not have a second surface. The administrator advised stated that they were waiting for sand so they could bring out the sandbox. It is also recommended that a storage box be added to the infant playground to keep the toys clean and in good condition.</p> <p>There is not enough shade in the preschool playground. A shaded area may be from natural shade (for example, trees), or may be created by using large beach umbrellas, tarps or a wooden structure. The supplies for the mud kitchen are still in storage. Now that the warm weather is here, it is recommended that materials be brought out to the outdoor play space. It is also suggested to add more materials and defined centers in the</p>

outdoor play space. One example would be a soccer net as a few children were kicking a ball around. The children mentioned they like to play soccer. This would allow the children to have an area without interfering with the other children. Another example would be a quiet area for reading, drawing or making crafts would be a good addition to the play space.

There are white shelving units in the throughout the facility that are wobbly and need to either have the screws tightened or be replaced. It was noted the two classrooms are sharing the same container of craft materials. Each classroom should have their own art materials that are always easily accessible to the children. It was also noted that there is only 1 puzzle in the 2/3 split class and. More puzzles and games need to be added to the classrooms. Some of the books are ripped and worn. These books need to be removed and replaced with new ones.

The diaper change table has a screw sticking out on the side. This needs to be repaired.

The glass on the exterior door in the preschool room is cracked, and the door does not seem to close properly as there is a gap where the lock is located. This gap can be an entry point for pests.
