General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the home at 9am, upon arriving the operator and children were outside playing in the outdoor play area. The daily attendance records, first aid bag and the children's water bottles were brought outside. The children had access to a variety of materials such as sand accessories for the sandbox, a mud kitchen with accessories, a slide, and a dramatic playhouse with loose soil and artificial flowers. The operator was observed playing with the children while supervising them. The operator was heard praising the children for sharing resources and taking turns going down the slide. The operator was attentive to the children's needs by wiping their noses and putting their shoes back on.

The operator was heard asking open ended questions to the children as they engaged in water play and playing with soil on a picnic table. The operator was heard saying "Wow you're such a fast learner, way to go!" to a child while at play. The outdoor play area was clean and safe for the children. A conversation was had about having protective surfacing under the play slide. Acceptable protective surfacing includes wood mulct, rubber tire chips, washed round pea gravel and specific sand.

A verbal prompt was given to the children to start cleaning up before transitioning inside. The operator ensured that all of the children were lined up before opening the gate and heading inside. Once inside, the children took off their outdoor shoes and jackets and placed them in their cubbies. The children were observed sitting at the lunch table while the operator took the children in the washroom one by one to change their diapers and wash hands before serving lunch. The washroom was clean and safe. The diaper changing policy was posted over the change table. Once completed, the operator served the children their lunches and offered water to the children. The children were supervised at all times while eating.

After eating, the children washed their hands before engaging in a playdough or coloring activity. The operator was observed sanitizing the table and chairs before going the children while at play. The operator was observed kneeling to speak to the children and was heard asking open ended questions to the children while they engaged in the playdough and coloring activities. The indoor environment was clean and well organized. Evidence of pre-planned activities were observed on a calendar. The parent information board was verified and found to be complete. Recent artifacts and learning stories were posted near the lunch table. Various indoor
