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General Comments
<p>In the Infant Room, infants were observed transitioning outdoors for a stroller walk with educators. The environment contained photos and documentation. Materials available included dramatic play items, art supplies, blocks, fidgets, and toys. The room appeared clean and organized at the time of observation.</p> <p>In the Two-Year-Old Room, the educator identified children's current interests as painting, using the climber, playdough, and outdoor play. Documentation on the walls included a smell-test activity, family-related displays, and stories previously read. Children were observed preparing to go outdoors. The educator placed each child's outdoor clothing in front of them and prompted children to dress themselves. The educator provided assistance as needed and remained engaged with the children throughout the transition.</p> <p>In the Three-Year-Old Room, educators reported that children's current interests include witches, potions, dinosaurs, and water play. During the observation, children were eating a snack consisting of crackers and applesauce. The environment contained learning invitations and documentation. Prior to snack, educators instructed children to clean up.</p> <p>In the Preschool Room, learning invitations included Magna-Tiles and craft materials. The room contained a variety of art, dramatic play, and literacy supplies. During outdoor time, children had access to jumping stumps, picnic tables, dramatic-play kitchen and restaurant materials, toy bikes, musical instruments, ride-on cars, trucks, a jungle gym, and a piano.</p> <p>Fire drills, the parent board, incident reports, and child-to-staff ratios were reviewed and were current and accurate at the time of observation.</p>
