<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Children and Educators in Daycare Room enjoyed a walk in the morning where they spent time looking for birds. Children were excited to share with ELCC inspector that they saw a duck on their walk. During snack, children easily conversed with their friends and educators.</p> <p>School-age children were making moon sand and playing with Lego.</p> <p>Children in the playschool room ended their morning in the outdoor play area.</p> <p>Educators were observed to engage with children at their level, asking open-ended questions and providing children with choice.</p> <p>Environments are set up with materials that provide choice and variety for the children. In preschool/ playschool room books and clipboards with paper are added to learning centres. This is a great way to ensure children are exposed to literacy throughout the learning environment and clipboards with paper invite children to represent their ideas in multiple ways and can be used to extend and expand learning.</p> <p>Documentation posted in entry way and classrooms depicts children's learning and activities they have recently participated in. Ensure all documentation posted is dated.</p> <p>Ensure children's last names and the year is documented on weekly attendance forms.</p>
