Comments: During inspection it was observed that Educators in the full day childcare room were doing 15-minute checks on children sleeping. These checks are only for children 0-14 months who sleep in a crib. Once the child is over the age of 15 months they are sleeping/resting on nap/mats cots with direct supervision in the same room as the educators. Discussed with educators in the room during inspection.

Comments: Full Day Childcare Room: *Small parts that can cause a choking hazard to children were on art shelf. * Small pieces of chalk on shelf. *Small letters on shelf. Discussed with educators in the room. These can be available for the children just not be accessible unless under direct supervision. Recommending placing these items in clear plastic bins with snap covers. When children want to interact and engage with the materials, then can indicate to the educators and to be used under direct supervision only.
