General Comments

A follow up to the renewal inspection occurred today.

All orders for compliance are completed and the facility is recommended for license renewal pending the recommendations from Fire and Public Health.

The children were observed during inside play, outside play, morning and afternoon snack, lunch and quiet time. Educators were observed tending to the needs of the children in their care appropriately.

Discussed ensuring that the sandbox is covered nightly as well as shade is provided in the outside play area. The QAM will follow up during the next inspection.

Discussed the School-Age room and ensuring that the environment is set up prior to the arrival of the children. Discussed having the school-age children in the 1/2-day preschool room every day as there are more materials

for the children to interact and engage with.

Discussed in the school-age room ensuring that children have enough snacks when they ask for more.

Children decide when they are finished eating. They are not forced or coerced to eat and denying food is not permitted. Staff members encourage children to respond to feelings of hunger and fullness.
