Comments: It was observed that a can of house paint was present in the play area. Toxic products must be stored in a locked storage space and be inaccessible to children at all times. The administrator removed the item at the time of the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the morning.</p> <p>The children were observed in both indoor and outdoor environments, including transitions between the two.</p> <p>Dolphins Room: The children were observed outdoors engaged in a variety of activities, including riding ride-on cars, using the rocking teeter-totter, playing with balls, and going down the slide. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in coloring, monster trucks, books, and exploring cause-and-effect concepts through activities such as dumping. Additionally, the children were observed eating lunch.</p> <p>Bees Room: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities indoors that included building with blocks and animals alongside their educator, doing puzzles, playing with the play kitchen, the children shared that they were making supper. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in bugs, painting, music, sensory activities, and cooking.</p> <p>Duckie Room: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities, including playing with playdough alongside their educator, climbing on the indoor jungle gym, and exploring the bug themed sensory table. Diaper changing was also observed, and appropriate procedures were followed. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in playdough, bugs, books, and water play.</p> <p>Turtle Room: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities, including building with blocks, reading books, building with boxes, and playing in a construction themed sensory bin. The educator indicated that the children are currently interested in construction, sand, and dramatic play, specifically dressing up as construction workers.</p>

General Comments

Monkey Room: Upon arrival, the group was heading out for a walk. When they returned to the facility, they were observed having sunscreen applied and playing in a tuff tray that included sand, buckets, shovels, and animals.

Frog Room: Upon arrival, the group was heading out for a walk. When they returned to the facility, they were observed in the outdoor play area engaged in a variety of activities, including playing with balls, building with large LEGO bricks, running, and jumping with their peers, and painting. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in superheroes, art, and LEGO.

The Bees, Duckies, and Turtles were observed together in the outdoor play area, engaged in a variety of activities. These included painting with natural materials collected during their walk, digging, coloring, climbing through tunnels, and using the dramatic play area. The children shared that they were having a picnic.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, ten randomly selected children's files, six educator files, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.
