<p>General Comments</p> <p>A Monitoring Inspection occurred July 2025</p> <p>The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities across indoor and outdoor environments, as well as during transitions between both environments. Observation also included snack and nap.</p> <p>Infants: The children were observed during nap time. Educators were sitting with the children, rubbing their backs. The educators indicated the children are currently interested in farm animals, painting, and sensory activities.</p> <p>Two-Year-Old Room: The children were observed during nap time. The educator indicated the children are currently interested in gardening, bugs, sensory activities,</p> <p>Two/Three-year-Old Room. The children were observed reading in the cozy corner. Two children were observed napping. The educator indicated the children are currently interested in unicorns, animals, and reading books.</p> <p>Preschool: The children were observed viewing their individual portfolios and doing puzzles. The educators indicated the children's current interest is trucks, sensory play, and things that go.</p> <p>Afterschool: The children were observed outdoors on the hammocks and helping set up the play yard with the play materials. The educator indicated the children's current interests are painting, open-ended art, sketching,</p>

and animals.

The indoor environment was set up with materials that invited the children to play. Several forms of documentation were visible throughout the rooms, including photographs, individual portfolios, children's print, learning stories/webs, and children's artwork. Books were selected to reflect the children's interests. Traffic areas, both indoors and outdoors, were maintained in a clean and clutter-free condition. A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.
