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General Comments A Monitoring Inspection was conducted this morning. Upon arrival, children were observed playing in their designated outside play areas. Infants – Educators stated that the infants are presently interested in emptying / filling containers, throwing objects, water & sand play, paint, and books. Infants were observed looking at books and preparing to paint. 2's – Children were observed during outside play. Educators stated that the children are presently interested in the sandbox, water table, babies, play doh, and singing. 2/3 – Children were observed playing outside and then entering the building for snack. Hand washing procedures were followed and observed. Children were observed sitting at their table for snack. After snack, educators were observed putting sunscreen on the children, before resuming outside play. 3/5 – Children were observed playing outside and then entering the building for snack. Hand washing procedures were followed and observed. Children were observed sitting at their table for snack. Once snack finished, children were observed gathered on the floor with their educator, singing songs. School age – Children were observed playing outside. Children were observed eating snack, inside their classroom. When asked what their interests were, the children stated that they enjoy building Lego cities, painting, and creating clay creations. A summer bucket list was observed on the wall, and many of the ideas have been checked off. Quality Assurance Monitor observed the upstairs learning / play environments while the children were downstairs / outside. Children's learning was visible through documentation – children's artwork, photos, and learning stories. Purposeful planning was evident – daily schedules, weekly themes and ideas, and lists of children's interests were observed. The parent board was observed and contained all required paperwork, including the most recent Monitoring and Renewal inspection. Quality Assurance Monitor provided their updated contact information, and this will be added to the parent board. New staff files were reviewed, and all required information was within the files. Several hornets were observed in the back rectangular fenced in play area. Educator stated that this area is not presently being used, due to the hornets. Educators stated that there are already plans in place to have this area re-sprayed.
