General Comments

Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including sensory opportunities, outdoor play, mark making, open-ended art, stories, songs, fine motor activities and loose part play. Educators observed engaging with the children at their level throughout the learning environments. Educators observed encouraging children to problem solve independently.

General Comments
Purposeful planning is evident within each learning environment. Documentation is displayed that supports the children's current interests and learning experiences. Next steps - include connections to the NB Curriculum Framework within documentation. A variety of open-ended materials have been added throughout the interest centers for the children to explore freely.
Handwashing routines were observed during washroom/diapering routines, before lunch and after outdoor play. Diaper changing routines were observed to be followed during inspection.
QA Monitor discussed EpiPens with staff, EpiPens must be taken with the group during outdoor play and on outings. Recommended storing EpiPen in front pouch of First Aid Kit when leaving the building.
A traditional Easter Dinner (ham, potatoes, broccoli, and cranberry sauce) was served for lunch today. Groups gathered together to share the meal. Educators and children set the tables with tablecloths, center pieces, books, paper and crayons.
Monthly fire drills are documented. New staff file (1) review was completed, all required documents are in place.
