### General Comments

Children were observed in play during today's monitoring inspection. A new invitation to hang decorations on a small Christmas tree in the younger preschool room created a lot of excitement and conversation among the children. In the older preschool room children were engaged in play at the train table, with different types of block (magnet and connect), and drawing at the art table. As their educator put together their classroom tree excitement was building and they were interested in telling me they were going to decorate it. Current interest topics are evident in the documentation posted in the environment. The variety of documentation showing the activities and learning of the children demonstrates how educators are listening and thinking about the children's learning and highlights their planning to build on the children's knowledge. Educators were observed engaging with children at their level, asking open-ended questions that invite the children to share their thoughts and ideas during their play.

The staff have created a good routine for managing the COVID-19 guidelines ensuring the safety of the children while providing a welcoming and engaging environment for them.
