| During today's monitoring inspection, a balance of indoor and out door play was observed. Outdoors, tables were set up with invitations for the children to engage with. Children were building with blocks, creating "salads" in the outdoor kitchen, and playing on the slide. Indoors, children were engaged in play with action figures, sensory play, painting gourds, and musical instruments.  In both the indoor and outdoor environments, educators were observed engaged with children at their level, supporting their play and learning through conversation and asking open-ended questions.  Children's current learning and topics of interests are evident in the documentation posted in the learning environments, and the materials available for children to engage with are set up to be easily accessible and inviting.
