Discussed with educator/administrator. Children will wash hands at the sink within the preschool classroom upon arrival going forward.			

General Comments
<p>Completed renewal inspection today. The environment was set up with interesting invitations prior to the children's arrival. The room was organized and clean. Some of the invitations consisted of paint, loose parts, instruments, and a sensory table with foam blocks, letters, tongs etc. The children appeared very comfortable with the daily routine.</p> <p>Current topics of interest were easily identifiable within the room. The children enjoyed spending time in the play kitchen area, preparing food with their peers whereas others enjoyed a newly constructed dramatic play area consisting of animals and vet supplies. Another interest that remains to be of interest is the model Ferry boat, which was constructed by one of the educators. The children were observed to be engaged within small groups and freely moved materials throughout the room. This integration of learning was encouraged by the educators.</p> <p>Some of the children also enjoyed experimenting with sounds and music by playing the piano and testing out various instruments.</p> <p>There were many opportunities for literacy apparent with letters, words, signage, and books strategically placed throughout the environment to capture the children's interest.</p> <p>Hand washing and snack time routines were also observed during the inspection.</p>
