<p>General Comments</p> <p>A monitoring inspection took place today in the morning.</p> <p>Maclaren Group: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities that included painting, building with the Nuts and Bolts builder construction set, and reading books alongside their educator. Additionally, the children were observed eating snack; today's snack was Cheerios with milk.</p> <p>Ropewalk Group: The children were observed transitioning from outdoors to the gym. In the gym, the children were observed running, jumping, and playing with the big bouncy balls. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in building, sensory activities, and gross motor activities.</p> <p>Churchill Group: The children were observed transitioning from outdoors to the gym. In the gym, the children were observed running, jumping, and playing with the big bouncy balls. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in ocean animals, playing with baby dolls, and sensory activities.</p> <p>Somerset Group: The children were not observed, as they were on a walk at the time of the inspection.</p> <p>Several forms of documentation were visible throughout all rooms, including photographs, children's artwork, learning stories, learning webs, and individual learning story books. The rooms were well organized and inviting, with a variety of activities set up. These included water sensory tables, a tuff tray with absorbent crystals that were blue, and a homemade rocket ship constructed from cardboard, all offering a varied supply of appropriate materials, books, and toys.</p> <p>A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and monthly emergency evacuation and fire drill records.</p>
