General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred today. The children were observed during inside and outside play, lunch, quiet time as well as arrival to the school-age program. Discussed with Operator, Administrator, and Educators the importance of defined interest centres and possible solutions to enhance both the preschool and after school room. Discussed nap/quiet time and creating one area of the room for those who require naps and having children who do not require naps, participate in quiet activities in the room such as art, puzzles, playdough, etc. Arranging the room to support this will help those children who require to sleep have a more peaceful area within the learning environment. Discussed possible changes to the outside play area after the removal of the large climbing structure. Adding gravel to level the ground, building a playhouse/shed on the stage to create an area for the children to explore in by adding art, blocks, dramatic play, Based on the children's current interests. Discussed the upstairs area and adding hooks to the empty room/old kitchen now that the appliances have

been removed. This would create an area for the children to hang their coats and store their boots and extra clothes out of the learning environment, thus maximizing the space that is available at the centre. Discussed adding shelves in this area as well to store items not being used such as extra toys, extra art supplies etc. Educators were observed having positive interactions with the children in their care and tending to their needs.
