General Comments

A Renewal Inspection occurred today.

Educators observed outside mediating between children, stepping in, or deliberately stepping back, to foster learning. Educators observed bringing the real world in by displaying and documenting the life cycle of spiders. Educators accommodate children's emerging interests by making children's contributions and thinking visible through displays, documentation, photos and artwork.

During outdoor play educators provided both the preschool children and the school-aged children with a variety of mark making materials for the children to create with while outside.

Preschool room was filled with documentation that is current and reflects the children's learning and interests. Educators were observed engaged in play with the children.

School-age room had cardboard creations such as Jurassic Park and ATM machines. School-age children were observed showing empathy to the younger children, helping solve conflict and role model positive behaviors.

All staff and child files were reviewed.

Proper handwashing, outside play and meals were observed.
