Administrator states that educators are documenting their programming on planning sheets, however there is no evidence that the plans are being implemented. Invitations based on the children's interests should be set up for the children daily throughout the rooms. Educators are to add materials and equipment to each environment to support individual interests.

Comments: There was an administration of medication form partially completed for a child who requires an inhaler. Additional information is required as educator was not informed as to under what circumstances this medication should be administered. Educators must be well informed of children's medical conditions and what actions to take in case of emergency. If children have medical conditions-Essential Routine Services and Emergency Plan should be completed. If a child has an extreme allergy-Extreme Allergy Management Plan is to be completed. These should be completed and kept with the child's medication and within the child's file prior to attending facility. There are a number of children with allergies/medical conditions. Licensing staff will follow up on required documentation at follow up inspection. General Comments

Renewal inspection was completed today. The children were observed within their indoor and outdoor environments. Hand washing routines were observed. Transportation vehicles appeared clean and were equipped with emergency contacts and first aid kit at time of inspection.

Within their indoor environment, children were observed participating in creative art, puzzles, playing basketball and playing board/card games with their peers.

Licensing staff discussed the importance of educators being well informed of all medical conditions and allergies, as well as the required need to improve outdoor play area inspections to enhance safety.

Educators report that they have just changed over to afterschool care from summer camp and that they are still in the process of setting up their rooms. Setting up these rooms as inviting environments with a variety of interesting materials requires immediate attention and needs to be done daily prior to the children's arrival. It will be important for the educators to spend time exploring the children's interests in order to design their space and plan their program. Discussed purposeful planning with program administrator at time of inspection. Topics of interest should be easily identified within the rooms.

General Comments

A new process has been implemented to collect information for child profiles and this is being completed online. Ensure that the new online system includes all required registration information as outlined in Appendix 1 and 2 of the Operator Manual. Much of this information was missing today within multiple files. Recommending that staff review all child profiles to ensure they have all required information and consent forms.

Ensure that Extreme Allergy Management Plans and Essential Routine Services Plans are completed as required.
