General Comments

The children did not participate in outdoor play this morning due to a wind chill of -23 degrees Celsius.

The children were observed to be actively engaged in play in their learning environments. Props and materials were set up and available for the children. Educators participated along with the children at their level and responded appropriately to their needs.

A variety of styles of posted documentation reflects the current interests of the children. Lovely displays of the children's art creations that supports their learning. Be sure that the children's portfolios are kept current. Discussed possibilities for programming and documentation for the school age group. Furthermore, discussed the value in mark-making and open-ended art in addition to having books based on the topics being explored within the interest centres so as to enhance opportunities for conversation and literacy development.

Pencils and pencil crayons are to be sharpened routinely to ensure that they are inviting for the children.

Infant room: Discussed sanitizing toys more frequently in an attempt to reduce illness in the room.

Challenge: What could you do as an educator in an effort to reduce the children's waiting time before lunch is served?
