General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. Children were observed inside and outside. 2's Group -Children were observed washing their hands after snack. Classroom had several forms of documentation learning stories, word webs, and photos. Children are presently interested in animals. Stuffed animals, food dishes, and animal crates were observed in this classroom. A building invitation was also observed in the building center. Children were observed playing in both areas. While outside, the children were observed sitting at a table, painting rocks. 2 – 4 Group – Children are presently interested in Camping. In their room, an indoor campsite was observed. This campsite included several different items, some of which included: a bon fire, BBQ, tent, food, patio, and patio lights. A Camp word web was also observed on the wall. Children were also observed during outside play, riding Plasma Bikes, climbing tires, and playing Basketball. 4/5 Room - children were observed during snack and free play. During snack, children were very excited to show off their new Earth Day placemats. Educators stated that the children made these placemats on Earth Day, to help save on their paper towel usage. After snack, children were observed during free play. Children were observed taking part in a variety of activities – gross motor activities (yoga, basketball, and gymnastics), building towers with blocks, reading books, and turning one of their educators into a princess. Throughout the facility, numerous forms of documentation were observed. Several well-defined learning centers were observed in each classroom / learning area. Several Positive Child Guidance techniques were observed. Educators were observed using positive language when interacting with the children, educators were observed preparing the children for transitions, and educators ensured that there was a good balance of activities in the program content. A conversation was had with operator regarding the bottom wooden step in the toddler's play area. This step may require some attention soon.
