Tables must be cleaned after each meal and/or activity daily. Paint pots and paint brushes dried up. Fresh paint needed. Pink Dora Chair soiled. Needs discarded. Preschool Room: Paint pots and paint brushes dried up. Fresh paint needed. Dramatic play area unorganized. Needs separate labeled bins. Bins throughout room accumulating dust and dirt. Bins need to be cleaned.

<p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Observed a balance of indoor and outdoor play this morning.</p> <p>Documentation in Infant Room shows children's interests and learning with photos and learning stories. It is nice to see the children experiencing new things. Well done!</p> <p>Ensure diagram floor plan and emergency evacuation plans are posted together at each exit. (See section 10.7.1 - Emergency Evacuation Plan in Operator Manual).</p> <p>Be sure staff are using staff attendance records on clipboards to sign in and out daily.</p> <p>When nap mats are used be sure that they are 5cms thick. (See section 9.2.3 - Rest Area in Operator Manual).</p> <p>Reminder of choking hazards for children under four years of age. Children can engage with these materials under direct supervision. (Example: Small Lego in Preschool Room)</p> <p>A healthy lunch was served today. Pancakes and Berries.</p>
