Twos Room: Walls to be painted. Bathroom door stained and unclean. To be cleaned and repainted.  Preschool Room: Walls to be painted. Floors and under shelving accumulating dust and debris. To be cleaned.  Discussed painting with administrator today. She stated that they are currently in the process of planning with maintenance team to have the entire facility painted.

A variety of open ended art materials must be accessible to the children. Art materials to be replenished daily. Examples of materials to include, but are not limited to: variety of paper in colours, textures and sizes, paint, paint brushes, paint rollers, mark making materials, glue, tape, feathers, tissue paper, cardboard tubes, fabric, yarn, ribbon, recycled items, items collected from nature, collage materials, etc.

Needs immediate attention. Books in poor repair. To be replaced.  Twos Room: Art shelf unorganized and accumulating clutter. To be organized in a way that invites children to explore art materials.  Preschool Room: Art shelves and dramatic play shelves unorganized and accumulating clutter. To be organized in a way that invites children to explore materials and engage in play. Improvements have been noted in the infant room in regards to room lay out. The educators have divided the room in different interest centres and have added more materials. QA Monitor left examples of ways to display materials throughout the room in way that is inviting.  Preschool room is in need of some decluttering and organization. Discussed ways to make improvements in making environments more inviting for the children with educators and administrator today.
