Comments: Baseboard trim throughout the facility in poor repair and missing pieces. To be repaired, replaced and painted.  Floors throughout the facility are in need of a deep clean and polish.

Comments: Infant Outdoor Play Area: Play kitchen, stove door broken with sharp edge. To be removed.  Preschool Outdoor Play Area: Play kitchen, faucet broken with sharp edge. To be removed. Stationary bike, broken pedal. To be removed. Little People jungle and treehouse set broken with sharp edges. To be removed. Puppets unclean. To be cleaned.  Staff must complete a visual inspection of outdoor play area frequently to ensure all hazards are removed.

Comments: Infant Room: Little People animal figures - stained and unclean. To be cleaned. Stained toys to be replaced.  Preschool Room: Top of green garbage can unclean. To be cleaned and disinfected daily and as needed. Dolls - stained and in poor repair. To be replaced.

Comments: During the Inspection today, it was determined that an infant often naps in a bouncing seat. Infants under 15 months must have a designated crib or playpen for napping and are not permitted to sleep in a bouncing seat. See section 9.2.3 - Rest Area of Operator's Manual for more information.

Comments: Preschool Room: Benadryl and Tylenol in First Aid Kit on the floor. Medication must be kept locked.			
39(3) Despite paragraph (2)(b), medications administered in cases of anaphylactic shock shall not be stored in a locked space.	39(3)	Sep 24, 2021	
Comments: Preschool Room: Epi-pen in First Aid Kit on the floor. Relief staff unaware of where Epi-pen is stored at the time of the inspection. All staff must be aware of life threatening allergies and where Epi-pen is stored. Discussed with administrator and staff today. Review of current allergies needed with all staff.			

General Comments
Renewal Inspection:  A variety of invitations are set up within each room. Children and educators were observed engaging in play both indoors and outdoors today. Documentation is posted that includes photos of the children, learning stories and art pieces. A variety of materials are accessible to the children within each learning environment.  It is evident that educators have been working toward creating environments that are inviting and purposefully planned.  A healthy lunch was served today - Orange Chicken Quinoa Bowl. Hand washing routines were observed.  Preschool Room - First Aid Kit left on the floor. First Aid Kits are to be kept in a place that is easily accessible to educators, however they must be out of reach of children.  Next steps: Adding some plants and soft materials to each environment. Displaying books throughout the room - Preschool Room Connecting documentation to the NB Curriculum Framework.
