Children and educators observed engaged in play both indoors and outdoors this morning. Educators observed engaging in meaningful conversations with children at their level. Each environment is set up with a variety of materials for the children to explore.

Documentation is posted within each environment that supports the children's current interests, learning and experiences. Documentation includes connections to the NB Curriculum Framework.

Twos Room - a gross motor area has been added to the indoor play area, this promotes big body movements and allows children to explore rough and tumble play.

Handwashing routines observed.

Broccoli, chicken and rice casserole was served for lunch.

Next steps:

Preschool - adding opportunities for sensory and gross motor play to the indoor play area.
