Comments: Preschool (3/4-Year-Old Room): * Small pieces such as google eyes, small pompoms, and buttons on art shelf. These are to available but not accessible for children 3 years and under. Recommending storing in a labelled, covered container on art shelf and used under direct supervision.

Comments: Preschool (3/4-Year-Old Room): * Storage closet door requires lock. Toxic products such as bug spray and fabric dye on shelf in closet.			

General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection occurred today, July 28, 2023. The children were observed during outside play, inside play, lunch and nap/quiet time.</p> <p>Discussed with Administrator Non-Reportable Incident reports and what should be documented. Facilities and parents work in collaboration to come up with solutions to best support the child when the child may be exhibiting challenging behaviors.</p> <p>Discussed transition time just before lunch in the preschool room. Recommending mentoring by Administrator/senior staff as to watch for children's cues when they are not interested in what is happening in the classroom. If an Educator finds that children are not wanting to listen to a story being read, that is time to change to something that may be more engaging and interactive.</p> <p>Discussed Parent Committee questions and Inspector has reached out to Manager for guidance and will get back to the Administrator.</p> <p>For lunch the children were served milk, homemade chicken burgers and sweet potato fries.</p> <p>Proper diaper changing and handwashing routines were observed occurring several times during the inspection.</p>
