Examples of materials to include, but are not limited to: variety of paper in colours, textures and sizes, paint, paint brushes, paint rollers, mark making materials, glue, tape, feathers, tissue paper, cardboard tubes, fabric, yarn, ribbon, recycled items, items collected from nature, collage materials, etc.</p> <p>Twos Room and Preschool Room: Wooden blocks not accessible to children. To be added.</p> <p>Sensory opportunities lacking within environments. Examples of items to add, but not limited to water, sand, rice, slime, playdough, materials for dumping and scooping.</p> <p>Twos Room: Reading area lacking materials that create an inviting space. Examples of items to add, but not limited to soft seating, a rug, soft lighting, soft toys, puppets, etc. QA Monitor left educators a challenge to focus on this area.</p> <p>Paper depleted in art area. <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities including stories, songs, and outdoor play this morning. Documentation is posted throughout the learning environments that supports the children's current interests (babies, running, roads/construction, running, dancing, vehicles and painting) and learning experiences. Documentation has connection to the NB Curriculum Framework.</p> <p>Infants were observed being held while fed their bottles. Handwashing routines observed. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance forms are completed. Homemade lentil, tomato and vegetable soup with parmesan cheese and naan bread was served for lunch.</p>
