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General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection occurred today. Upon arrival at the childcare facility, Inspector observed that the infants, 2's and 2-3's rooms were on their way to play in the outside fenced play area. The 3-4-year-old room were observed engaged in play and activities in their indoor learning environment.</p> <p>Inspector observed the younger groups of children engaged in playing with bubbles, riding cozy coupe cars, playing in the water and sand, and climbing on structures. Inspector observed transitions occurring smoothly, and handwashing and diaper changing routines were occurring throughout the day.</p> <p>Educators were observed during the inspection sitting with the children during lunch, engaged with them during their learning and play, speaking kindly and appropriately to them and using positive child guidance techniques.</p> <p>It was observed that each of the learning environments have created a documentation binder where children's past learning is stored for review and is accessible for the parents. Children's art was also observed displayed in each of the learning environments.</p> <p>In the infant room, Inspector observed documentation and learning stories of the children exploring sensory activities with paint and paper, exploring a sensory bin with Easter grass, flowers, and foam butterflies and a wooden step stool has been added to the window area for the children to see their outside world.</p> <p>In the 2's room, Inspector observed documentation and learning stories of the children engaged in blowing bubbles and exploring wooden loose parts in the outside play area. Learning stories and a web of "animals" was observed. Children have been exploring animal sounds, types of animals and what animals eat.</p> <p>The children in the 2-3's room documentation was observed of the children dancing, exploring ice cube painting and mark making.</p> <p>The 2's room and 2-3's room will combine sometimes due to the number of children in attendance.</p>

General Comments

The children in the 3-4-year-old room were observed having a picnic outside for lunch with their peers. Documentation the walls support the children's current interests in "Dinosaurs." Children have created dinosaurs with paint, sand, glue and Q-tips, a chart of their favourite dinosaur was observed posted on the wall. A learning story and pictures of the children creating muddy dinosaur footprints was also observed. The children have also been exploring the water table inside, using scoops, funnels, measuring cups, bowls, and spoons.

Facility is recommended for license renewal pending the recommendations from Fire and Public Health.
