General Comments
Monitoring Inspection Infant Room: The children were observed eating lunch prior to nap time. The educator shared that the children are currently interested in movement activities, cause and effect experiences, and playing with balls. Two-year-old room: The children were observed singing and dancing with their educator, using Paw Patrol cars and figures, bouncy balls, and dramatic play before transitioning to nap time. The educator indicated that the children are currently interested in music, animals, and gross motor activities. Two-Three-Year-old room: The children were observed finishing lunch. Several children moved downstairs with an educator, while others remained upstairs with an educator to prepare for nap time. The group downstairs were observed listening to music, using spinning chairs, and toy cars. Preschool Room: The children were observed preparing for lunch, with handwashing occurring beforehand. Following lunch, the children were observed engaged in a variety of outdoor activities, including exploring the water table, searching for bugs, riding Plasma Cars, chasing bubbles from the bubble machine, digging in the sandbox, and helping to plant flowers. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in bugs, water play, and outdoor activities. Several forms of documentation were visible throughout all rooms, including photographs, learning stories and children's artwork. The rooms were well organized and inviting, offering a varied supply of age-appropriate materials, books, and toys.

General Comments

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, daily information sheets, one educator file, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.
