Comments: Victor Leamen Room - Swim Camp: Materials that support the children's current interests are lacking within the environment. This week the day camp is Swim Camp. Materials are to be added to the environment that support this interest-based camp for which the children are registered. Examples of materials to add include kickboards, pool noodles, dive rings, toy boats, measuring cups and funnels for water exploration, sea animal figures, water safety visual aids, Lifeguard/beach dramatic play materials, and books about swimming, aquatic animals, and water safety. Ensure materials are added that make the interest of the camp visible within the environment each week. Order carried forward, as the compliance date identified during the previous inspection has not yet passed. Art materials have been added to the environment.

General Comments Monitoring Inspection: The QA Monitor conducted a Monitoring Inspection this morning to follow up on the cleanliness of the Victor Leamen Room and cubby area. These areas have been cleaned, debris removed and a cleaning schedule has been implemented and documented. Improvements have been noted however; the rooms are still in need of some deep cleaning and organization to ensure the environments are inviting and engaging for children. Discussed creating prop boxes for the different types of interest-based camps that are held each year. McMurray Room - materials/accessories have been added to the workbench area. The children and staff were not observed today as they were on a field trip to a local beach. The facility has an adequate number of staff in place to meet the reduced ratio for swimming during the field trip.
