Comments: Child-to- staff ratio was not met at the pool today. QA Monitor observed the group in the pool was short one staff. QA Monitor brought this to educator's attention and children were removed from the pool. Reminder - support workers can not be included in swimming ratio, when working with a child one on one. School-Age Ratio while swimming is 8:1.

Monitoring Inspection:

Full monitoring inspection not completed today, as QA Monitor was visiting with the focus of swim time. Swimming ratio has been an on going order for compliance at this facility.  
 QA Monitor went over swimming ratios with staff today.  
 Swimming must not happen if there is not enough staff to meet the reduced ratio at the pool.

All other orders for compliance complaint - back dated to renewal inspection and follow up inspection.
