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General Comments Monitoring Inspection - Full Day - Summer Program: Children and educators observed cleaning up snack, during transition to swimming and during outdoor play. Children were observed cleaning up their snacks independently. Each child applied sunscreen before swimming and outdoor play. Children were permitted to choose swimming or outdoor play. Children remained waiting a line for an extended period as other children prepared for swimming. QA Monitor recommends having small groups of children prepare for swimming, once they are ready, have them go outside to play rather than wait in a line for extended period of time. Purposeful planning is documented on a weekly planning sheet. Planned activities support the ongoing interests of the children. QA Monitor recommends setting up the picnic tables in the outdoor play area with art materials, board games and/or sensory opportunities. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be reduced by half for swimming. Staff conducted regular headcounts to ensure all children were accounted for. Attendance was taken before entering the pool area. First Aid Kits were taken with staff to pool area. New staff file (5) review was completed. One staff member does not have a valid First Aid/CPR certificate, the staff is enrolled later this month. Ensure staff is not left alone with children until complete and certificate is in file.
