### General Comments

#### Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including outdoor play, building, and open-ended art. In the Fours Room a small group of children with their educator explored magnetic tiles on a light table, they engaged in meaningful conversations as they engaged with the materials.

The children in the Three/Fours Room were observed during the transition from lunch to nap time. Each child was encouraged to tidy up their lunch independently before they settled in for nap. During nap the environments are dim, and educators put soft music on to ensure the environment is relaxing for children. The children's cots are set-up with bedding and are situated at an adequate distance apart. Educators observed comforting children as they settle in for nap.

## General Comments

Homemade chicken noodle soup, turkey salad and egg salad sandwiches were served for lunch.  
Monthly fire drills are documented.  
Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection; including a reduced ratio during swimming.  
New staff file (1) review was completed.  
Incident logs are complete and signed by parent/guardians.  
Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (4/7) requirement.
