Comments: Bleach was observed to be stored in a cabinet with a broken lock. QA Monitor discussed with staff during inspection and bleach was immediately moved to a cabinet with a working lock. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments
<p>Monitoring Inspection - PD Day:</p> <p>Room #5 is the only one operating on this license this afternoon due to low attendance for the PD Day. The other environments were observed by QA Monitor; however, children were not present.</p> <p>Children and educators observed during transition to outdoor play this afternoon. Staff were observed taking small groups out as they were ready in their winter clothing to avoid long wait times. Educators were observed offering children choices and redirecting their behaviors. Children were observed engaging in outdoor play in the snow this afternoon.</p> <p>QA Monitor noted that recommendations from last Monitoring Inspection have been implemented regarding documentation. Documentation is displayed throughout each environment that supports the children's current interests (pop music, vehicles, and Christmas). Open ended art pieces and photos of the children are displayed.</p> <p>Cereal was served for snack this afternoon. Handwashing routines were observed during washroom routines. Monthly fire drills are documented.</p>

General Comments

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.
New staff file (3) review was completed. One Inclusion Support Worker does not have a First Aid/CPR certificate. To be completed and certificate added to file. Staff not to be left alone with children until complete.
