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General Comments Monitoring Inspection: Children and educators were observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including gym games, building, art, and outdoor play. One group of children were engaged in an obstacle course, fort building and basketball in the gym. The group within the indoor play area were exploring a variety of building materials - blocks, Magantiles and Lego. Purposeful planning is evident through documentation on planning sheets and invitations set-up throughout the environment. It was determined that new staff will be attending some training around purposeful planning in the coming week. Colouring sheets were set out for children to use; instead of relying on pre-made colouring sheets, children should be provided with a variety of open-ended materials such as blank paper, stapled booklets, markers, crayons, pencils, and stickers to create their own colouring books. When children design their own pages, they use their imagination, make creative choices, and express their unique ideas. Recommend creating a collaborative group colouring book and have copies for the children to take home/access within the environment. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. New staff file (5) review was completed; all required documents are in place.
