The environment was lacking in documentation to reflect the children's current interests. Comments:	Some shelving units and materials (board games/ toy boxes), within the Group 1 room are dusty and in need of cleaning. Bins for markers/pencil crayons are also in need of cleaning. Ensure bins are cleaned/sanitized routinely along with the materials. The surface of heaters/vents within both rooms (Group 1 and 2) are dusty and in need of cleaning. The bins under the art easel within Group 2 are also in need of cleaning.						

Completed renewal inspection today.

Screening occurred upon arrival to facility. Visitor log is being kept on site. Group logs were reviewed and are being completed. Cleaning schedules/routines were also reviewed.

Hand washing routines were observed during today's inspection.

The children engaged in a balance of indoor/outdoor play today.

It is evident that toys and materials are being cleaned within the facility. Ensure that materials are returned to bins and organized/set up prior to the children's arrival.

Invitations were set up for the children within the Group 2 room and the children were encouraged to participate. The educator within the room promoted the children's creativity and spoke to the children in a respectful manner. The children were eager to show their work that was on display. Within this room, interests were apparent within the environment in the form of documentation (posters, murals, art pieces) and areas that had been set up throughout the room.

Extreme Allergy Management Plans and Essential Routine Services Plans were reviewed and up to date.
