Comments:	During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that in the 2-year-old classroom, one staff member took a child to the washroom, leaving the other staff member alone with seven 2-year-olds. This exceeded the allowable child-to-staff ratio. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded both staff members that when one staff member leaves the room, they must ensure that the remaining staff member is not left with more children than permitted by the ratio. The Quality Assurance Monitor also discussed the matter with the administrator, who explained that staff had
