General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct the renewal inspection. The ratio was respected during the inspection.

The QAM had a discussion with the Administrator regarding Ibuprofen (Advil) consent in the child's file. A facility can only provide Acetaminophen (Tylenol) with the parents' consent. Ibuprofen can only be provided by the parents with the consent form signed. The administrator must create another consent form with only Acetaminophen to be provided with the consent of the parents. The new form must be signed by the parents and inserted in the children's file. This will be verified during the next monitoring inspection.

The QAM also observed in certain children's profile that CPS was inserted for the emergency contact information. For emergency contacts, CPS is no longer accepter

The QAM was not able to observe the completion of the 10 h of professional development for one staff. The eligible educators have until the 30th of June to complete their 10h of professional development for the renewal year.

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The QAM observed a group of school aged children having a professional development day. The children were observed playing in the outdoor play area. The children were also observed transitioning to lunch time and then nap time for the preschool children. The QAM also observed the children in one classroom transitioning to quiet play time after resting for 30 min on their cot. The children then had their afternoon snack. The other school aged children were also observed arriving to the center from school.
